Terry Dee Madole, 78 of Higginsville, Missouri, formerly of Windsor, MO passed away on Monday, February 23, 2026, at Western Missouri Medical Center in Warrensburg, Missouri.

He was born Sunday, June 29, 1947 in Clinton, Missouri, to Hurschel Madole and Frances (Laughlin) Madole.
