September 8, 1950 - October 2, 2014

Tim Shillingburg, a beloved husband, dad and grandpa, age 64 of Higginsville, Missouri passed away on Thursday, October 2, 2014, in Higginsville.

Born Friday, September 8, 1950 in Clarksburg, West Virginia, he was the son of the late Pete Shillingburg and the late Dorothy (Landis) Shillingburg. He and Jennifer Randolph were united in marriage November 5, 1973.

Retiring from the Internal Revenue Service in 2007, Tim lived in Blue Springs, Missouri, then in Odessa, Missouri for ten years moving to Higginsville in 2012. He was a member of Grace Bible Church in Lee's Summit, Missouri.

Now with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, Tim is survived by his wife of 40 years, Jennifer Shillingburg of the home in Higginsville; one daughter, Vanessa Cohron, her husband Michael and their son, Ryan of Warrensburg, Missouri; and one brother, David (Linda) Shillingburg of The Villages, Florida. His family will love him always.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Terry Shillingburg.

A Funeral service will be at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, October 7, 2014 at the Hoefer Chapel, 1600 Main St. Higginsville with Pastor Adam Godshall officiating and Kari Godshall as pianist. Interment will be in the Higginsville

City Cemetery.
