Timothy J. "Tim" Leonard, age 63 of Raytown, Missouri died on Sunday, April 6, 2014, at his sister's home.

Born Friday, February 23, 1951 in Martinsville, Indiana, he was the son of the late James Andrew Leonard and the late Marjorie Ruth (Sellers) Leonard.

Mr. Leonard lived in the Kansas City area for over 25 years, moving to Florida in 2013.
