Verna Aversman, age 88 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Wednesday, February 18, 2015, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

Born Saturday, February 27, 1926 in Lincoln, Missouri, she was the daughter of the late Henry Schroeder and the late Amanda (Richter) Schroeder. She married Marvin F. Aversman on September 19, 1945.
