Virgil H. Koch, age 85 of Odessa, Missouri died on Monday, August 18, 2014, at Golden Living Center in Odessa, Missouri.

Born Thursday, July 18, 1929 in Bay, Missouri, he was the son of the late Henry Edwin Koch and the late Leona Marie (Rauter) Koch. He and Verneal C. Winter were united in marriage on April 29, 1951.
