July 9, 1926 - August 30, 2015

Virginia Gray, 89, of Higginsville, Missouri died on Sunday, August 30, 2015, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville, Missouri.

Born Friday, July 9, 1926 in Carrollton, Missouri, she was the daughter of the late Frank Gilbert Tweedie and the late Carrie Lou Booker Tweedie. She married William N.
