



Wilmer W. Mahnken

August 23, 1922 - February 16, 2014

Wilmer W. Mahnken, 91, of Concordia, Missouri died on Sunday, February 16, 2014, at Western Missouri Medical Center in Warrensburg, Missouri.

Born Wednesday, August 23, 1922 in Concordia, Missouri, he was the son of the late Louis Mahnken and the late Sophia Meyer Mahnken.

Mr. Mahnken lived most of his life in the Corder and Higginsville area. He served as a Corporal in the Army Air Corps during WWII. He married Olga Haesemeyer who preceded him in death in January, 1982. Also preceded in death are son, Stephen Mahnken, stepson, William H. Huntsman; brother, Alfred L. Mahnken, and sisters Edna Wyatt and Lorene Ward. He married Phyllis Y. Huntsman in Newark, NY on October 7, 1983.

Mr. Mahnken retired from farming in 1969 but worked construction and was a truck driver for Black Industries in Concordia before retiring in 1988. He was a member of the Corder VFW and a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church of Higginsville.
